2 Preparing for Installation

2.1 Preparing the Installation Site

- Do not install the AP rack in an area prone to fire or explosions.
- Keep the AP rack at least 500 meters away from the ocean and do not face it towards the sea breeze.
- The installation site should be protected from water and flooding, seepage, dripping, or condensation.

2.2 Installing the Device

1、 USE screws to attach the mounting bracket to a US-style wall outlet box



2、 Plug the cable into the POE port of the AP



3. Attach the AP onto the mounting bracket with screws
